Why This Matters

Dangerous goods can cause fires, explosions, chemical burns, or environmental damage if handled improperly. Understanding and following safety procedures helps protect workers, property, and the environment.

Common Causes

- Improper storage or labelling of hazardous materials
- Lack of knowledge about chemical hazards
- Incorrect handling or transportation methods
- Failure to use required protective equipment

Practical Safety Actions

- Always read labels and Safety Data Sheets (SDS) before handling materials
- Store hazardous materials according to compatibility and safety guidelines
- Use proper PPE such as gloves, goggles, and protective clothing
- Follow safe handling and transportation procedures
- Report spills, leaks, or damaged containers immediately
